Madalene Robertson Boritzki Scholarship Award	Elementary, middle, or high school. One male and one female student, both becoming elementary, middle, or high school Teachers. If sophomore or above, must have 3.5 GPA. Enrolled in at least 12 hours. <u>May continue to receive the award but must maintain 3.5 g.p.a.</u>
Frances Hamilton Buchholz Memorial Scholarship	Elementary Education. Woman majoring in elementary ed. Non-renewable.
Aubrey F. and Leta E. Chastain (by Richard Houk)	M.S. or B.S. Graduate of a southwest Missouri high school. Enrolled in the College of Education, preparing for a career in education as a teacher or counselor at the K-12 grade levels. If sophomore or higher, overall g.p.a. must be 2.5. Undergraduates to be enrolled in at least 12 hours each semester; graduates enrolled in at least three hours each semester. <u>May be renewed, but must apply</u>
Anna Lee Dugan Memorial Scholarship	Elem. Ed major enrolled in at least 12 hours per semester. If junior or senior, must have maintained overall GPA of 2.5+ & a GPA of 3.0+ in Elem. Ed. <u>May be renewed automatically.</u>
Empo Allen Harmon Scholarship	CFD or Elementary. Child and Family Development or Elementary Education Major; enrolled 12 hours each semester. Must be at sophomore level or above with an overall GPA of 3.0+. <u>Renewed automatically with 3.0 GPA.</u>
Bernice Jackson Scholarship	Any COE student, includes graduate students. Preparing for a career in education as a teacher, administrator, counselor, librarian, or other professional role; enrolled 12 hours each semester; g.p.a. of 2.5 or more except high school students (determined by high school performance). May be renewed but must apply.
Dr. Jim Layton Scholarship	M.S. in Reading or B.S. in Education majoring in early childhood, middle school, elementary, or special education. Awarded annually. 12 hours per semester required.
Emily Nelson Moseley Memorial Scholarship	Special Education. At least a sophomore + enrolled in at least 12 hours in COE's Department of Elementary Education, Reading, and Special Education has priority. <b>Renewed automatically</b> as long as satisfactory academic progress. Consideration given to high school performance, college potential as indicated by aptitude tests, and to leadership qualities as well as to a <b>strong desire to teach special education students.</b>
One-Room Schoolhouse	Enrolled in a degree program offered through the departments within the College of Education. Must be a sophomore/junior/senior or a graduate student w/minimum g.p.a. of 2.5. Enrolled in 12 hours undergrad or 6 hours graduate.
Marilyn Graff Rhoades Memorial Scholarship for Education	Elementary Ed: Elem. Ed. Major; must be third year student and have completed 56 hrs w/ a minimum 3.0 GPA. Must be high school graduate from the southwest Missouri's 24-county area. Financial need, leadership potential, and likelihood for making worthwhile contributions to society are all to be factors in the award. <u>May be renewed for senior year if 3.0 is maintained.</u>

Dr. Leonila Pangilinan Rivera/ Student Council for Exceptional Children Fund	Special Education: Enrolled fulltime in Dept. of Reading and Special Education & interested in a career in Special Education. Awarded to a student enrolled at SMSU with an interest in special education. When awarded to an entering freshman, consideration of high school performance, college potential & leadership qualities; when awarded to sophomore+, student must have maintained an overall GPA of 2.5. Must be a member of the Student Council for Exceptional Children or have plans to become a member.
Jim and Ruth Craig Scholarship	Any major, any degree in COE or secondary education. Must have graduated from a southwest Missouri high school & is enrolled at Missouri State University in the College of Education, preparing for a career in education as a teacher or counselor at the kindergarten through 12 <sup>th</sup> grade levels. Must be a sophomore or higher and enrolled in at least 12 hours per semester if undergraduate and at least 6 hours if graduate. Must have at least a 2.5 overall GA.
Jim & Vi Pollard Memorial Scholarship Fund	Declared major in any field of education. If sophomore or higher, must have 2.5 overall GPA in the major. Enrolled in at least 12 hours per semester. Renewable automatically.
Patricia K. Scott Endowment	COE student, undergraduate. Annually to undergrad student enrolled in the College of Education who is a high school graduate from Greene County, MO. Must be enrolled in 12 hours. If awarded to an incoming freshman, consideration will be given to high school performance, college potential as indicated by aptitude tests, & leadership qualities. When awarded at sophomore+, must have maintained overall g.p.a. of 3.0 full-time student.
Harry J. Sicheluff Memorial Scholarship	Graduating senior entering M.S. Any education major, senior. Annual award at the "Spring Honors Assembly" in the spring to a graduating senior who possesses qualities that suggest promise of becoming an outstanding teacher. Upon being accepted and enrolled in graduate school, a cash award will be made also. Per F.A., has been awarding to a graduating senior in the past
Burnell Joe Sumners Memorial Scholarship	Student in the College of Education who plans to teach elementary or secondary. If enrolled as junior or higher, overall g.p.a. must be 2.5 and 3.0 in education coursework. Must be enrolled in at least 8 hours per semester. <b>Automatically renewable.</b>
Myrtle P. Teter Memorial Scholarship Award	Enrolled in COE; must be enrolled in 12 hours each semester, maintaining a GPA of at least 3.0, renewed automatically if student maintains satisfactory progress of 3.0.
Frank F. Thompson Memorial Scholarship	Teacher education major, undergrad or MAT. Musts demonstrate special promise in the teaching profession. G.P.A . must be that as required for admission to teacher education Must be majoring in teacher education.
Wiley and Virginia Woodring Memorial Scholarship	COE education major. Awarded to a student enrolled in COE who plans a career in teaching. Must be enrolled in at least 12 hours per semester. Full-time education major w/ plans to have a career in teaching. May be renewed but must reapply.
Inmon Memorial Scholarship	M.S. Counseling major; full-time student. Renewed automatically as long as the student maintains satisfactory academic progress and is a full-time student. Pays incidental fees and a book allowance not to exceed ten percent of the incidental fees. Must be US citizen w/ preference for native Missourian.

Schoen Memorial Scholarship</p>	<p>Child Development major w/ career goal to work w/ abused children; when awarded to sophomore+, maintained an overall GPA of 2.5+ &amp; GPA of 2.5+ in CFD; submit written statement outlining interests in working w/ abused children &amp; overall career goals; enrolled in at least 12 hours per semester. <u>Renewed automatically</u> as long as student maintains satisfactory academic progress.</p>
<p>Dick &amp; Pauline Tuter Memorial Scholarship</p>	<p>High school graduate from McDonald County or Newton County schools in MO enrolled at MSU; major in CFD, Hospitality &amp; Restaurant Admin., or Vocational Home Economics Edu.; full-time student; must maintain overall GPA of 2.5+ &amp; a GPA of 3.0+ in major field of study.</p>
<p>George Wise Scholarship</p>	<p>Child and Family Development. When awarded to a student(s) enrolled at junior level or higher, must have g.p.a. of at least 3.0 in Child &amp; Family Development. Applicants to submit written application stating career plans and philosophy of Child &amp; Family Development. Must be enrolled in at least 12 hours each semester. <u>May be renewed automatically for an additional year.</u></p>
