Transfer Scholarships 2022-2023

General transfer scholarship policies

To qualify, students must:

- Be transfer students from other regionally accredited colleges and universities in the United States.
- Earn qualifying transfer credits following high school graduation and prior to enrollment at MSU.
- Apply for admission by the deadline specified for each scholarship and be admitted.
- Be enrolled full-time at MSU.
- Be lawfully present in the United States.

All scholarships can be renewed for two years beyond the first year (6 semesters total). Scholarship Enrollment and Renewal Standards also apply to recipients of transfer scholarships.
