Dr. Swearingen reported Dr. Sottile went to a CAEP conference. CAEP doesn't seem to really know want they want because it keeps changing. If you offer a degree, you have to go through a review process. This could be a state review process. When CAEP makes a decision, Dr. Sottile will let RFT know. They are doing a tripod where they are interviewing elementary and secondary students on teacher effectiveness. Elementary students will be interviewed verbally. Secondary students will be interviewed online. This is to evaluate teacher impact.

Updates from programs on CAEP: Daniel Hellman has gone for CAEP training; can go to him for updates or information. Dr. Camp reported working on spa report. Dr. Sheffield reported working through rubric. Dr. Chang reported working on standard five. Dr. Sawyer is looking at what is included now and what needs to be included. Dr. Sawyer spoke with Dr. Sottile who thought everything was okay in terms of the rubric and standards.

APR – a progress report that higher education will have to now complete. This is a unit report that will come out in January. This also has different standards listed.
