Interns: Compensatory Time

Because interns follow the school calendar for their placement schools, they are in the classroom many days more than the traditional student. For this reason, interns are given five compensatory, or "comp," days of release time. Interns may choose to take these days over Winter Break or at a different time throughout the school year. Comp time should be scheduled in advance with the approval of the intern's Master Teacher and Teacher-in-Residence.

Restrictions regarding when Comp Time can be taken may be set to meet the needs of the placement school. TiRs should discuss with interns the window in which they may take their Comp Time and how far in advance it must be scheduled and approved.

Comp days may not be taken on Seminar days.
