Interns: Expectations

- 1. Consistently does more than is required.
- 2. Uses varied learning experiences in his/her classes, including:
 - a. student centered active involvement/hands-on experiences for the students,
 - b. instruction which provides a reasonable challenge for students,
 - c. differentiated instruction to address individual learner needs.
- 3. Plans far enough ahead, if assigned, and gives the plans to the Master Teacher to allow time for suggested changes to be made before the plans are implemented.
- 4. Uses a variety of means to evaluate student learning, grading, and returning student work promptly.
- 5. <u>Communicates</u> effectively, including:
 - a. checking email at least twice a day (in the morning and afternoon) and replying to emails promptly, politely, and appropriately.
 - b. explaining so students understand,
 - c. handling student questions,
 - d. <u>listening</u> and understanding what other persons are saying (Teacher-in-Residence, Master Teacher, Principal, University Instructors, and Internship Coordinators),
 - e. communicating enthusiasm and conviction about the importance of his/her responsibilities as a co-teacher,
 - f. asking questions and discussing plans with the Master Teacher.
- 6. Responds positively to mentorship by:
 - a. being open to suggestions,
 - b. implementing the suggestions of TiR, MT, Principal, University Instructors, Coordinator
 - c. being pleasant and cooperative,
 - d. planning lessons the way the TiR, MT, University Instructors have requested.
- 7. Demonstrates professional attitudes and behavior, including:
 - a. punctuality, good attendance, and "on-the-job" positive attitude,
 - b. ethical, discreet conduct,
 - c. appropriate relationships with students and staff,
 - d. appropriate grooming,
 - e. appropriate language,
 - f. thorough preparation for teaching.
- 8. Shows initiative by:
 - a. looking for ways to help and offering to do so, rather than waiting to be asked.
 - b. not having to be frequently reminded about what to do and when.
 - c. completing work competently and on time.
- 9. Gives every indication of continuing to do excellent work when hired to teach.
- 10. Is a teacher I would like to teach with the following year or one I would like for my own children to have.
